How do I apply?



Online

You can apply online at elections.nsw.gov.au. Applications must be received before 5pm on Monday 29 November 2021.



By post

Instructions to complete this form

1. Complete all details in BLOCK letters using a blue or black pen.
2. Use a tick (✓) where it is applicable.
3. You must tick at least one of the reasons in the “Application details” section that applies to you.
4. You must sign the application. Your application will not be accepted if it is not signed or is incomplete.

Note: The information you provide must be true and complete. Giving false or misleading information is a serious offence carrying a monetary penalty or imprisonment or both.

What happens next?

- The NSW Electoral Commission will process your application and will attempt to contact you about the outcome of your application (if you have provided your contact details).
- Postal Vote Packs will be sent out from the week beginning 8 November 2021.
- The Postal Vote Pack will contain ballot paper(s), instructions, a postal vote certificate envelope and a reply paid envelope. Once completed, this pack must be received back by 6pm, Friday 17 December 2021.

Post your vote as soon as possible to allow for Australia Post delivery periods.

General Postal Voters

If you are registered as a General Postal Voter, you do not need to complete this application. Your postal vote pack will be sent automatically to the address you have chosen. To check if you are a GPV or to send your postal vote pack to a different location call 1300 135 736. To find out if you are eligible to register as a general postal voter and to apply, you can also visit the Australian Electoral Commission website.

General postal voters automatically receive ballot papers in the mail for federal, state and local government elections.

Privacy

The NSW Electoral Commission requires the personal information in this form to make a decision about whether you are eligible to vote by post and for other election-related purposes. Your information will only be disclosed by the NSW Electoral Commission if lawfully required or authorised in accordance with the *Local Government Act 1993*, *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998* or other legislation. We may also use the information to contact you about this application and your eligibility to vote by post or other voting options at future elections.

Political parties and candidates may also send out postal vote applications directly to voters, which are sometimes accompanied by their electoral material and a reply paid envelope. If you choose to return your completed application to the party or candidate, they must forward your form to the NSW Electoral Commission for processing. Please note, however, the NSW Electoral Commission does not control what a party or candidate does with any personal information it may collect from your application form. You do not have to send your application form back to the party or candidate. Instead, you can choose to return it directly to the NSW Electoral Commission via the methods noted above. You do not have to use a form that is sent to you by a party or candidate. You can apply to the NSW Electoral Commission directly, visit elections.nsw.gov.au.
